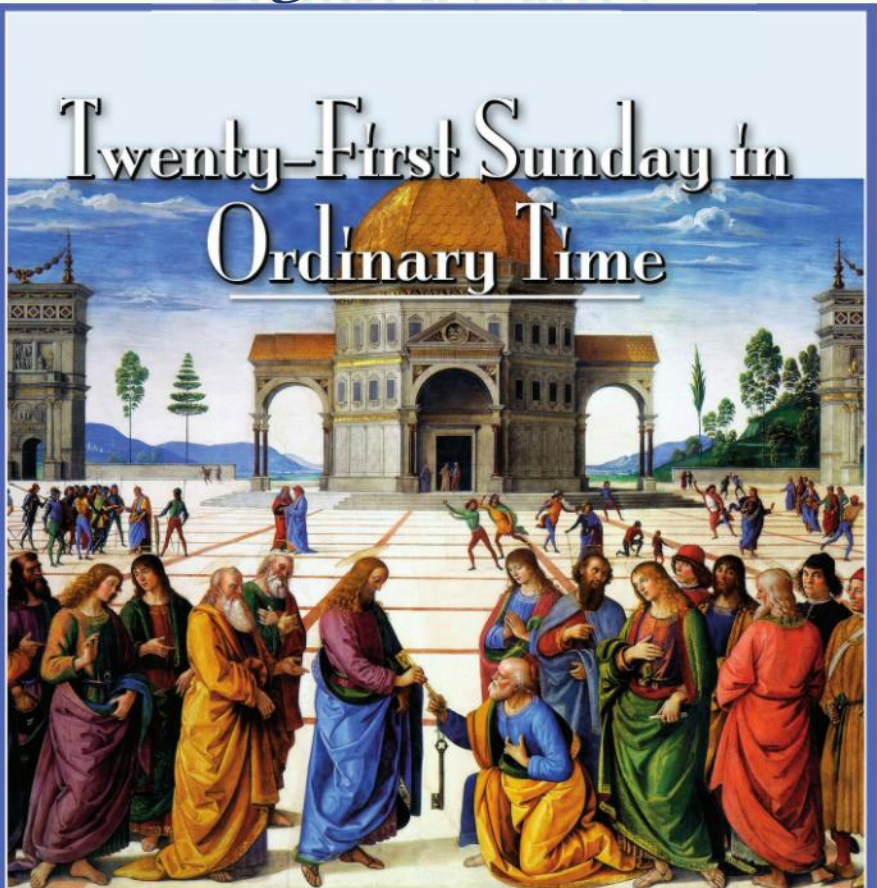

## RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Sometimes when I ask one of my children about who they were with or about a classmate at school they answer me with, "You don't know them." Apparently, since I do not know him or her personally, I do not need to know the person's name. I may not know this person but I do know that he or she exists in the everyday life of one of my children. If my children don't share with me anything about their friend or classmate, I can only assume he or she has no great impact on my sons' or daughter's daily lives. Of course, sometimes the response I get is simply my teen being a typical teen.

Has Jesus had a significant impact on your life? Do you know Jesus personally? If someone asked you about him what would you say?

My children respond the way they do to me because they are still young and immature. However, some adults are immature as well: immature in faith. We shy away from any discussion of God in our lives and we rarely share our faith. Most days we will not be asked the question, "Who is Jesus?" But we will be in situations where we are being called to share a little bit about ourselves. If Jesus has truly changed our lives and we never seem to want to share something about him with others, they may as well assume that he has had no real impact on us. On the other hand, if we are mature disciples in Jesus Christ, I suspect that others can't help but know about the great friend we have in him. --Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

### WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC TRADITIONS EXPLAINED

Question: Does the pope choose his own name or is it given to him?  
Why does it change?

Answer: The pope picks his own name. Although all of the popes since the Middle Ages have done so, it is not required to change your name. The first pope to change his name was John II in 533. His given name was Mercury, the name of a pagan god and he felt that his was not an appropriate name for the head of the church and he changed it. The last pope to keep his given name as pope was Marcellus II in 1555. Pope John Paul I was the first to choose two names. Until the election of Pope Francis in 2013, the last pope to choose a new, unused name was Pope Lando in 913.

When a pope chooses a new name, it might indicate his hopes for his reign, or tell us about his view of spirituality; it might also reflect continuity with a predecessor. In the early thirteenth century St. Francis of Assisi had a vision in which Jesus commanded him, "Repair my house, which as you see is falling into ruin." In choosing St. Francis as his namesake, Pope Francis was pointing to a beloved saint who embraced radical simplicity, poverty, and care for the poor. As Pope Francis himself put it, "Oh, how I would like a church which is poor and for the poor!"

## The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

“Each parish offers special sessions and special  
 resources for children and youth preparing for First  
 Confession, First Communion, and Confirmation. A  
 general requirement is that a child preparing for a  
 sacrament has been **actively and regularly**  
 attending religious education **prior to beginning the**  
**sacramental preparation program**. Baptismal  
 certificates and other sacramental records are  
 required for the child or youth preparing for a  
 sacrament and for his or her sponsor. Sacramental  
 preparation programs include special study,  
 prayerful preparation, regular attendance at  
 classes, participation of parents in designated programs,  
 certification of readiness for the sacrament, and regular  
 participation in the liturgical life of the parish. The  
 reception of sacraments is a **right** for baptized  
 Catholics, a right that carries with it the **responsibility**  
 for conscientious and reverent preparation.”

The expectation in the **Saint Anne and Saint Jude Office  
 of Faith Formation** is that upon entering into a  
 Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a  
 Religious Education program for at least one full year  
 prior (according to attendance records). Once entered  
 into a Sacramental program, it is the expectation that  
 the youth will attend classes and retreats faithfully and  
 participate fully. If you know your child is going to be  
 absent on a scheduled class day, please notify the  
 teacher or DRE. All contact information is available on  
 the front cover of the bulletin.
