

521 PROJECT UPDATE MARCH 22,2018

The parishioners of St Anne and St Jude Roman Catholic Church are ready to build a new church on our 521 properties where we can all worship together in one facility. Our new church will reflect the history and character of all peoples of our Catholic Community.

In January 2018, The St Anne and St Jude Parish Council and Finance Council voted unanimously to move forward with this building project.

On February 28,2018, The Bishop approved our request to move forward with our new church building project on our 521 properties.

With parishioner input, a Steering Committee and a Church Design Committee were formed, and a Fundraising Committee is in the process of being formed.

Mark Crabbe and Andrew Williams are Co-Chairs of the Steering Committee, Joey Duggan is Chair of the Church Design Committee, and Mark Mossell is Chair of the Fundraising Committee.

The Steering Committee and Church Design Committee have meet on several occasions, including with Jay Seth and Scott Bell to review information from the building process up until now. In addition, we meet earlier this week with the Charleston Diocese BRAC for a site review.
