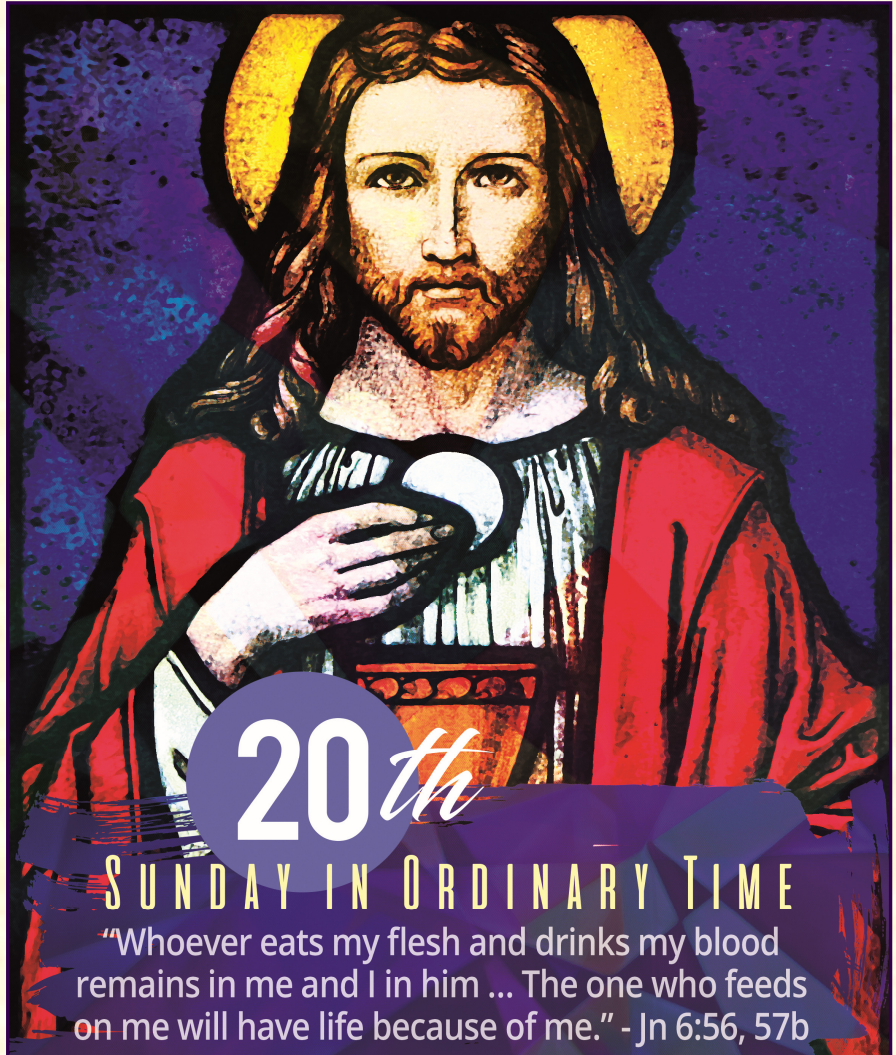

If your child needs to be baptized please stop by the church office to submit your form. If you are registering a child for a Sacrament class. You must submit the child's baptismal certificate upon registration.

Our Commitment to a Safe Environment

The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

"Each parish offers special sessions and special resources for children and youth preparing for First Confession, First Communion, and Confirmation. A general requirement is that a child preparing for a sacrament has been **actively and regularly** attending religious education prior to beginning the sacramental preparation program. Baptismal certificates and other sacramental records are required for the child or youth preparing for a sacrament and for his or her sponsor. Sacramental preparation programs include special study, prayerful preparation, regular attendance at classes, participation of parents in designated programs, certification of readiness for the sacrament, and regular participation in the liturgical life of the parish. The reception of sacraments is a **right** for baptized Catholics, a right that carries with it the **responsibility** for conscientious and reverent preparation."

The expectation of **Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church** is that upon entering into a Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a Religious Education program for **at least one full year prior**. Once entered into a Sacramental program, it is the expectation that the youth will attend classes and retreats faithfully. If you know your child is going to be absent on a scheduled class day, please notify the teacher, DRE or Dir of Faith Formation. August 19, 2018 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In this Sunday's Gospel, the conflict escalates in the Bread of Life Discourse. Confusion is mounting in the crowd. "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Their minds were thinking literally, not mystically. Jesus doesn't seem to help, however, and only drives his point home with more emphasis. "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." Jesus would later institute the Eucharist at the Last Supper. There he would definitively establish the sacramental reality in which bread and wine become substantially his own Body and Blood. We celebrate this sacrament in the Mass. Perhaps we do not always understand what we receive. "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." What is the essence of food and drink? Food nourishes our bodies, providing essential calories for our survival. Water is used throughout the body to cushion joints, regulate body temperature, and protect sensitive tissues like the brain. When we receive the Eucharist, we receive the spiritual equivalent of these essential elements. Like water, the Eucharist strengthens the sanctifying grace moving through us. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." The Eucharist connects us intimately to Jesus and confirms our union with him. That is why we abstain from the Eucharist while in a state of mortal sin. It would be a contradiction and deep disrespect to these words of Jesus. To receive the Body and Blood of Jesus is not a right but a gift we receive with deep humility.

As we receive the Bread of Life, grace strengthens our love, separates us from sin -- even wiping away venial sins -- unifies us with the universal Church, and helps commit us to humble service. Together we are nourished for our mission in the world!

19 de agosto de 2018 20º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Una hermosa e importante tradición Católica es la Adoración al Santísimo Sacramento. Este tiempo privado ante el Santísimo ayuda a responder a la pregunta de los judíos, que discutían entre sí. ¿Cómo puede este darnos a comer carne? (Juan 6:52). También, es de gran ayuda a nosotros, para experimentar una profunda apreciación de lo que es este regalo Divino de la Eucaristía.
