If your child needs to be baptized please contact the parish office. Registration for the Sacrament program is now closed.

Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church will present a sexual abuse prevention program, **Teaching Touching Safety**, to our students on **Sunday, October 21<sup>st</sup>** with a make-up date of **Sunday, October 28<sup>th</sup>**. This program is provided to us by the Diocese of Charleston and is a part of our ongoing effort to help create and maintain safe environments for all children and youth in our care. The scheduled lesson is being offered to all students at Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church. As parents, you have the right to choose whether your student participates in the program. We encourage you to read the **"overview"** and **"lesson plan"** assigned to your child's age group to understand exactly what your child will be taught.

**It is important to note, this is basic prevention education and is in no way to be considered sex education or education on private body parts.**

Neither of these components fall within our educational mandate to provide your child with the information needed to keep them safe from those who would do them harm.

If you wish to "opt" your child out of the prevention education session, please complete the "opt-out" form at (located in your child's registration packet) and return it to your child's teacher no later than, **Sunday, October 7<sup>th</sup>**.

**Cabe resaltar que esta es una sesión básica de educación preventiva y no debe ser considerada como una clase de educación sexual o educación sobre las partes íntimas del cuerpo.** Ninguno de estos componentes está incluido en nuestra orden educacional para brindarle a su niño la información necesaria para protegerlo de aquellos que quieren hacerle daño.

Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church is dedicated to providing a safe environment for our children to learn their faith and further a love of Christ. We are committed to upholding the "National Charter for the Protection of Children & Young People" as established by the United States Council of Bishops. All adults who work with children must:

- \*Complete the Safe Haven—It's Up To You Online Program
- \* Be Screened by Law Enforcement (Background Screening)
- \* Adhere to the DOC Code of Conduct (Copy available in Church office, Church library, DRE office & online at [www.sccatholic.org](http://www.sccatholic.org))
- \* Read and sign the DOC Sexual Abuse Policy and Procedures.

#### The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

"Each parish offers special sessions and special resources for children and youth preparing for First Confession, First Communion, and Confirmation. A general requirement is that a child preparing for a sacrament has been **actively and regularly** attending religious education prior to beginning the sacramental preparation program. Baptismal certificates and other sacramental records are required for the child or youth preparing for a sacrament and for his or her sponsor. Sacramental preparation programs include special study, prayerful preparation, regular attendance at classes, participation of parents in designated programs, certification of readiness for the sacrament, and regular participation in the liturgical life of the parish. The reception of sacraments is a **right** for baptized Catholics, a right that carries with it the **responsibility** for conscientious and reverent preparation."

The expectation of **Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church** is that upon entering into a Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a Religious Education program for **at least one full year prior**. Once entered into a Sacramental program, it is the expectation that the youth will attend classes and retreats faithfully. If you know your child is going to be absent on a scheduled class day, please notify the teacher, DRE or Dir of Faith Formation. All contact information is available on the front cover of the bulletin OR on the parish website.

## September 30, 2018 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

As we go about our days, we necessarily label, classify, and prioritize. What's "in" and what's "out" on our priority list? Because humans are social beings, we tend to do the same thing with people. We can only invite six people to the dinner party. Our young child wants to invite certain friends to her birthday, but we're keenly aware of who the parents are, and the prospect of spending several hours with them is enough to give us pause.

In today's Gospel, Jesus' disciples face a classification problem. They've seen another person driving out demons in the name of Jesus. They recognize him, a non-Apostle, as clearly "out." And yet "Jesus replied, 'Do not prevent him? whoever is not against us is for us.'" Jesus recognizes real faith in the would-be exorcist. In our own lives, Jesus invites us to recognize others' good intentions. They should not be cut off simply because they do not line up with all our personal preferences. What, then, is deserving of such a fate?

"If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off? if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out." When his listeners blame others, Jesus tends to pivot the conversation to their own lives. In this case, the message is clear. What we really need to cut out is that which keeps us from Jesus. If over-commitment causes us to lose patience with our family, doubt God's providence, and become consumed with self-reliance, cut something out. If certain friendships lead us time after time into gossip and slander, cut it out. In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to live intentionally in our discipleship. Are we ready?
