Why Your Support for our local YWCA Women's shelter is Critical

- 1 in 3 women will be impacted by assault or domestic violence during their lifetime.
- On average, 24 people per minute are victims of physical violence or stalking by an intimate partner in the United States — more than 12 million women and men over the course of a year.
- **Nearly half of all women and men** in the United States have experienced psychological aggression by an intimate partner in their lifetime (48.4% and 48.8%, respectively).

If you're looking for ideas on how to help those in need, here are 10 items to consider donating to our local women's shelter:

- **Sports Bras** – All sizes Small - XXXL
- **Underwear** – multi packs are great - all sizes
- **Socks** – women and children's
- **Toiletries** (deodorant, soap, shampoo, combs, brushes, hair ties and hair products, etc.)
- **Women's sanitary products**
- **Diapers and wipes**
- **Cosmetics and nail polish**
- **Cell phones** - Old phones may be given to women to use in case of an emergency or to provide a contact number for job applications. If the shelter can't use the phones themselves, they may be able to receive funds for them through an exchange program.

Fr. Kenneth Masong will join us April 6th through 9th for a Lenten Mission. On Monday the 8th and Tuesday the 9th confession will be offered at Saint Anne from 6:00pm to 7:00pm. The Mission will begin at 7:00pm in the church.

Fr. Kenneth Masong is a professor of philosophy at St. Vincent School of Theology as well as at the Ateneo de Manila University and the Our Lady of Good Counsel Seminary where he is the appointed Dean of the Philosophy Department. He is also a professor of theology at Mother of Good Counsel Graduate School of Theology and the University of the Assumption. His previous teaching experiences include working as a professor of philosophy and theology at Columban College where he served as an Associate Pastor at St. Columban Parish. He also worked as an Instructor at St. Augustine Minor Seminary in Zambales (2001). In 2007, he accepted the position in Katholieke Universiteit Leuven as a teaching assistant in Metaphysics Seminar and Research in Philosophy until 2009. He has presented papers in symposiums and conferences here in the Philippines as well as in Belgium, France, Sweden and Czech Republic. While in Claremont California, he became Process Studies. He is also a member of the American Catholic Philosophical Association and the Philosophical Association of the Philippines.

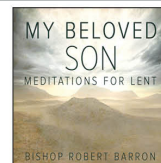
