

521 PROJECT UPDATE MARCH 31, 2019

We plan to build a new St Anne and St Jude Roman Catholic Church only (one building) during Phase 1 of our 521 Building Project.

The church is cross shaped, with room for 800 seats. The total size of the new church is 16,700 square feet.

The estimated cost, including infrastructure, is approximately \$6 million dollars.

We have \$2.6 million dollars in savings from our One Faith One Family Fundraising Campaign.

We are starting our “It’s TIME” Fundraising Campaign in conjunction with the Diocesan Bicentennial Campaign. Our goal is \$1.8 million dollars.

We plan to use the St Anne Campus and St Jude Campus for school and worship during Phase 1 of our building project.

The Steering Committee and Building Design Committee has had several meetings this year with Rob Montgomery, architect for our church building project.

Our latest plan, called the “538 Plan” is to build a church with a temporary social hall and office spaces. This church will seat 538. Once we complete future building phases on our 521 property, we will convert the social hall and office spaces to pew space for a total of 800 seats.

We are working on finalizing a draft of our plan to be presented at a town hall meeting in the next few months. We can then present our plan to the Charleston Diocese BRAC for approval. Once this is done, we can enter Design Development, which takes a year.

Our intent is to have a “shovel in the ground” in 2020.
