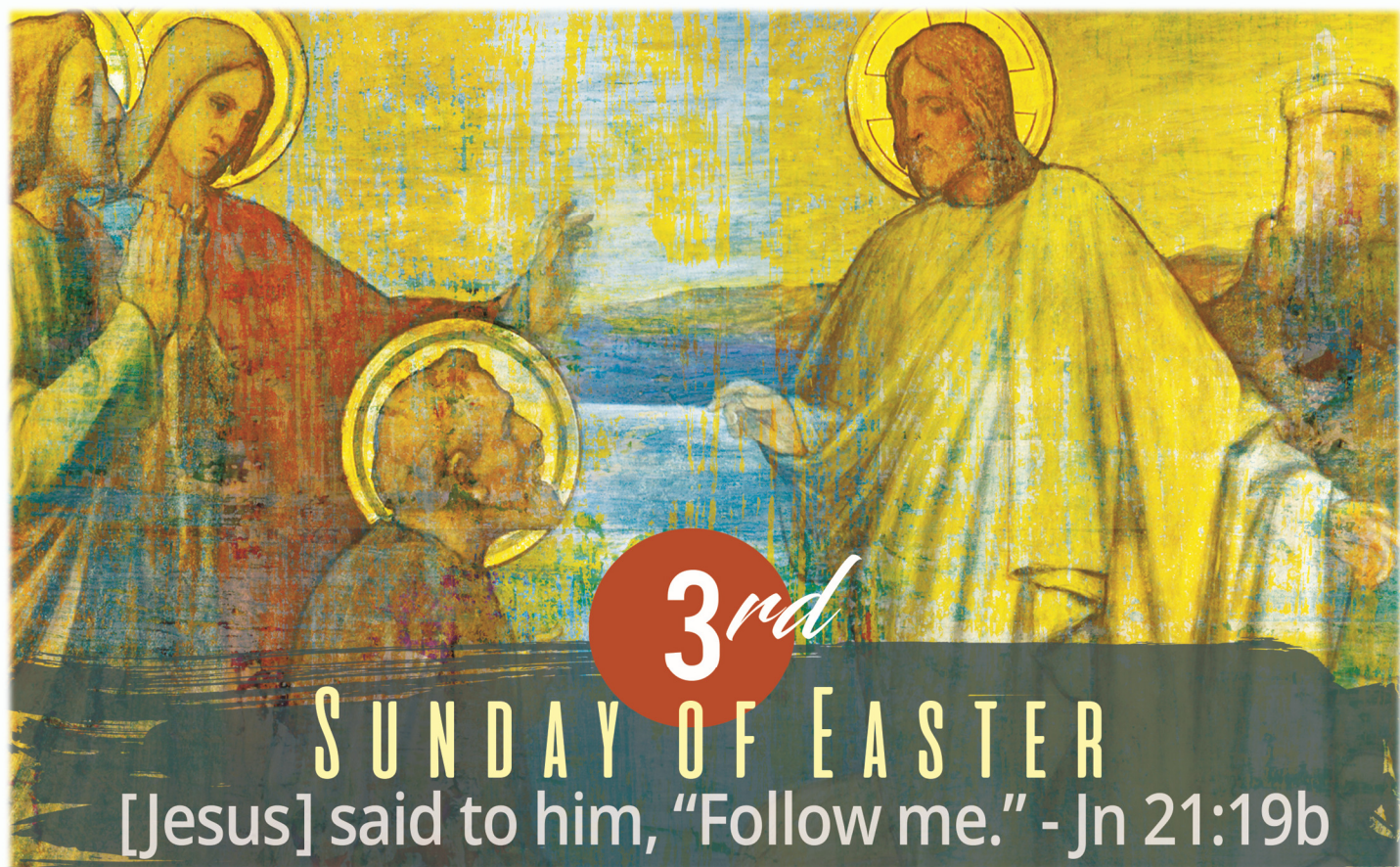

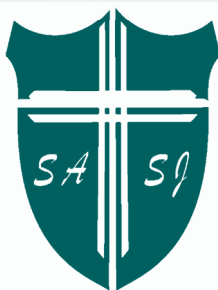

As you may be aware, Bishop Guglielmo released a letter, the list of credibly accused priests, and a Question & Answer document on Friday afternoon. If you have not yet seen this information, you can access it via the homepage of the Diocese's website. The address is www.sccatholic.org.

The Diocese of Charleston encourages any victim of abuse by Church personnel to first report the abuse to law enforcement, and then to contact the Diocese's Victim Assistance Coordinator, Louisa Storen, at 800-921-8122, to request access to pastoral resources, including a counseling referral when appropriate.

Bishop Guglielmo asks everyone to continue to pray for all victims of sexual abuse and their families that they may find peace and healing.

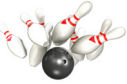


Tuesday Adoration at the Saint Jude Location

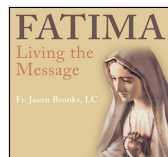
