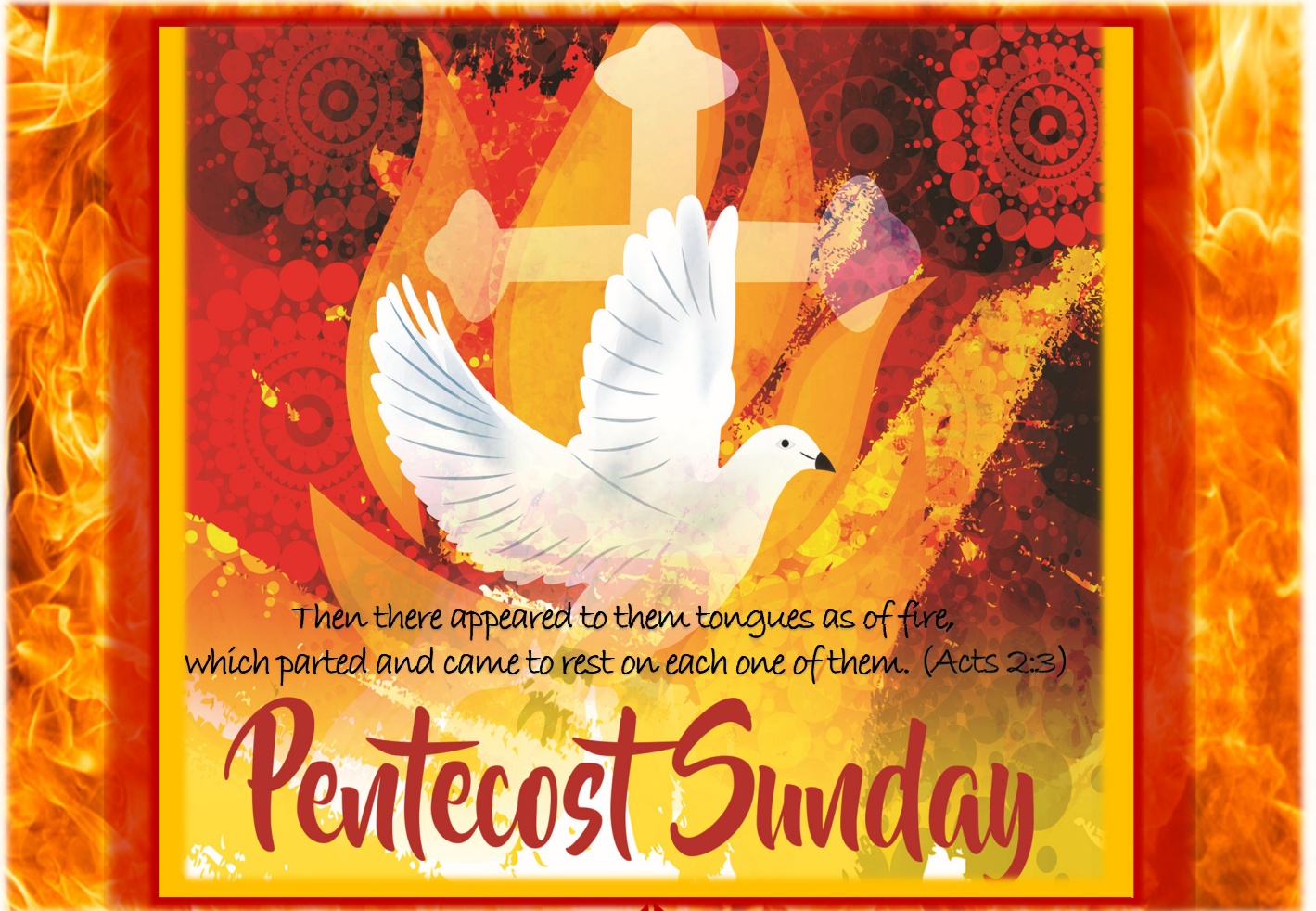

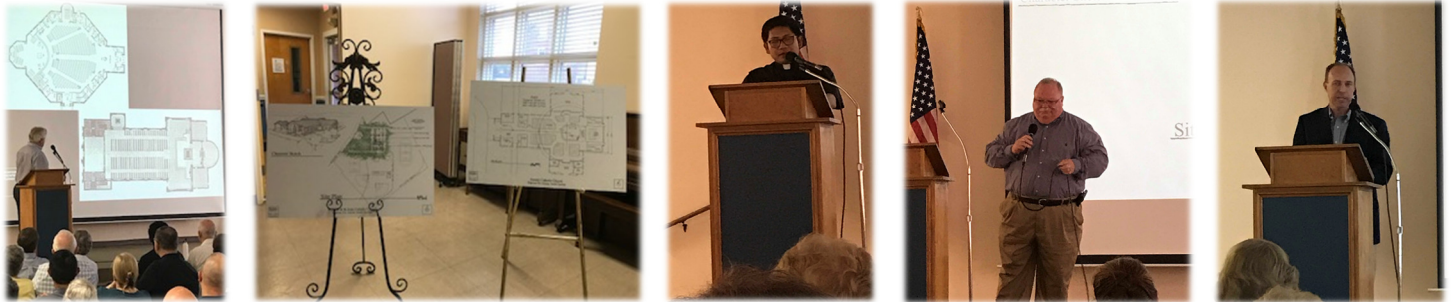

### Confirmation Program 2019/2020

If you have a rising 9th grade student who is eligible to enter the Confirmation Program at SASJRCC, **NOW** is the time to begin planning. Please make sure that the Office of Faith Formation has a valid Baptism and Communion Certificate on file. Also, begin thinking and talking to your child about choosing a Confirmation Sponsor. The requirements to be a Sponsor are:

- ◆ I have received the Catholic Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.
- ◆ I attend Mass regularly on Sundays & Holy Days.
- ◆ I have attained the required minimum age of 16.
- ◆ I am not the parent of the person being confirmed.
- ◆ **if married:** My current marriage is canonically valid and Recognized as such by the Catholic Church.
- ◆ My manner of life is in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken.
- ◆ I am **In Communion** with the Catholic Church and able to receive Communion at mass.

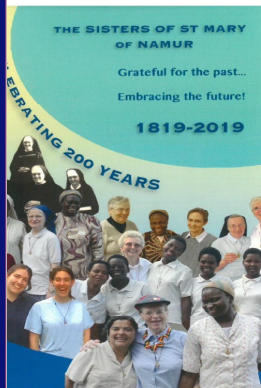
