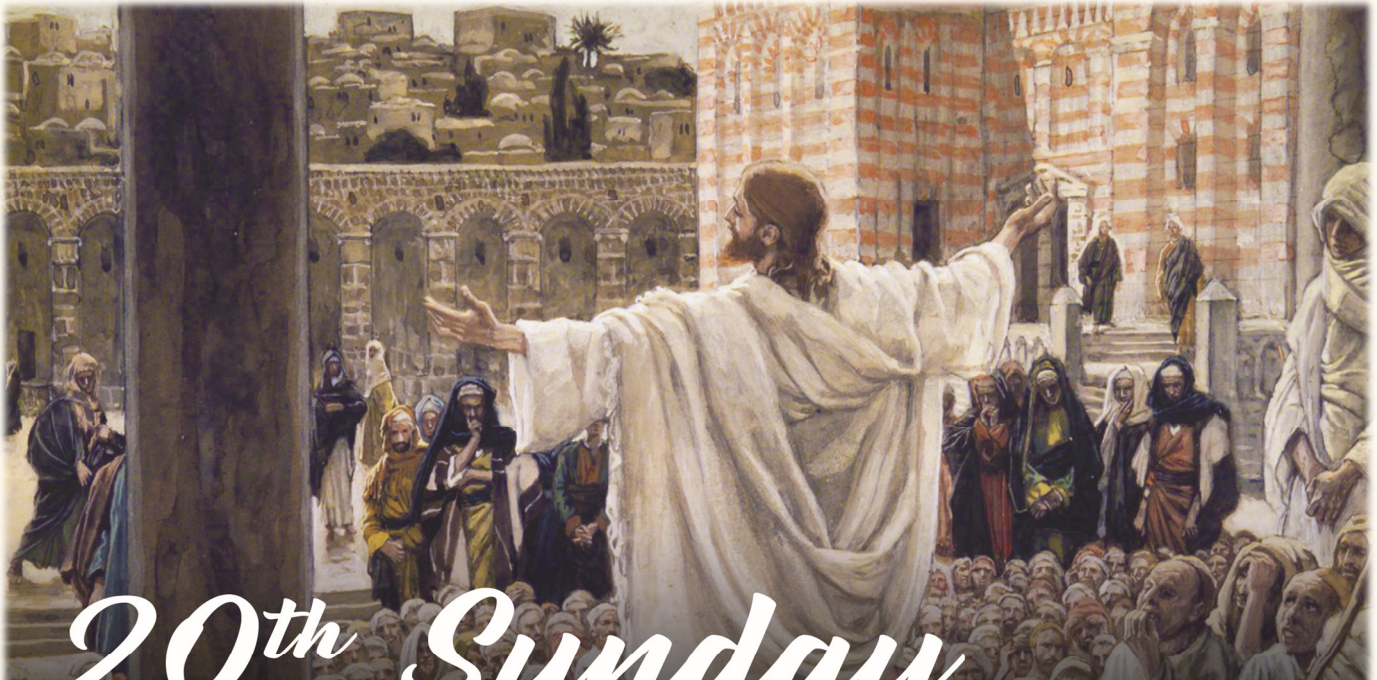

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The Prince of Peace wants to set the world on fire? This Sunday's Gospel can sound more intense than what we may be accustomed to. It's a passage of contradictions. Jesus so clearly prays for unity, yet here he speaks of division. Why would our God who comes as an offering of love speak so frankly about causing relationships to be torn apart?

The sobering truth is that Jesus is divisive. We see this throughout the Gospels, as the Pharisees critique him, the Romans condemn him, and not everyone in the crowd is enthusiastic about his words. Jesus has not come for the purpose of dividing, but what he does is so radical that it upends the status quo. And it doesn't end with his preaching and miracles! "There is a baptism with which I must be baptized." Jesus isn't talking about his baptism at the Jordan River, which has already occurred, but the passing through the waters of death on the Cross and rising again to new life in the resurrection. This is divisive stuff! Christ's spiritual fire turned the "fathers" - the Jewish people and Pharisees - against the "sons" - the common people. Not everyone wants the Gospel Jesus is preaching. Not everyone wants to be set on fire with the desire to love others. Some prefer to put on a warm sweater and curl up in front of the TV. In living and loving as Jesus did, we, too, might ruffle some feathers. In disciplining our teenage child for sneaking out, we may cause some division (temporarily, we hope!). In standing up to gossip and the spread of cruel rumors in our workplace, we might cause division. In emphasizing the dignity of both the desperate mother and the unborn child, we might cause division. Not everyone wants the Gospel Jesus is preaching. Not everyone wants the Gospel we are invited to live. But that's no excuse not to live it.

Confirmation Program 2019/2020

The Confirmation Classes will be held every other Sunday at the Saint Jude Location from 3:00pm - 4:45pm. The class will be strongly encouraged to attend the 5:00pm Mass together and then move on to the Youth Group Meeting for dinner and fellowship from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. If you have a rising 9th grade student who is eligible to enter the Confirmation Program at SASJRCC, **NOW** is the time to begin planning. Please make sure that the Office of Faith Formation has a valid Baptism and Communion Certificate on file. Also, begin thinking and talking to your child about choosing a Confirmation Sponsor.

The requirements to be a Sponsor are

- ◆ I have received the Catholic Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.
- ◆ I attend Mass regularly on Sundays & Holy Days.
- ◆ I have attained the required minimum age of 16.
- ◆ I am not the parent of the person being confirmed.
- ◆ **if married:** My current marriage is canonically valid and Recognized as such by the Catholic Church.
- ◆ My manner of life is in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken.
- ◆ I am **In Communion** with the Catholic Church and able to receive Communion at mass.

First Holy Communion Program 2019/2020

If you have a rising 2nd grade student who is eligible to enter the First Communion Program at SASJRCC, **NOW** is the time to make sure that a copy of your Child's Baptismal Certificate is on file in the Office of Faith Formation. Students will **NOT** be admitted into any sacrament program without a valid baptismal certificate. **If your child (of any age) needs the Sacrament of Baptism, call the office and schedule an appointment. 803-773-3524.**

The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

The expectation of Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church is that upon entering into a Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a Religious Education program for at least one full year prior. Once entered into a Sacramental program, it is the expectation that the youth will attend classes and retreats faithfully. If you know your child is going to be absent on a scheduled class day, please notify the teacher, DRE or Dir of Faith Formation. All contact information is available on the front cover of the bulletin OR on the parish website.

If you are currently or thinking of home schooling your child for Religious Education, please make sure you are following the Diocesan Guidelines below.

“Occasionally, parents wish to home school their children for religious education. This is permitted in the diocese **when it is done under the guidance and approval of the parish's pastor or administrator and the director or coordinator of religious education.** It is diocesan policy that children and youth receiving their religious education at home participate in the sacramental preparation programs offered in their parishes with other religious education and Catholic school students.”

Si por alguna razón tu hijo hubiera que faltar algún domingo, favor de avisar al maestro.

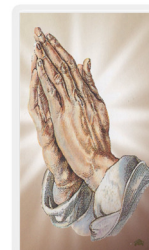

LIVE THE LITURGY

Our baptismal rite instructs the parents and godparents of the newly baptized children, "May they keep the flame of faith alive in their hearts." Faith has often been associated with fire. While fire can be useful and welcomed as a source of light and warmth, it can also be devastating and destructive. The Gospel is very much like this. On the one hand, Jesus speaks of healing, liberty, mercy, and forgiveness. On the other, he challenges the secular mindset and ideology, risks opposition, and pushes people out of their comfort zones. We are more attracted to things that make us feel better about ourselves. Equipped with the flame of faith, are we willing to see the bigger picture and risk popularity and self-preservation in favor of the kingdom of God?

VIVIR LA LITURGIA

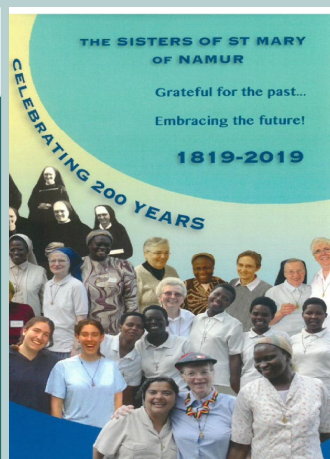
