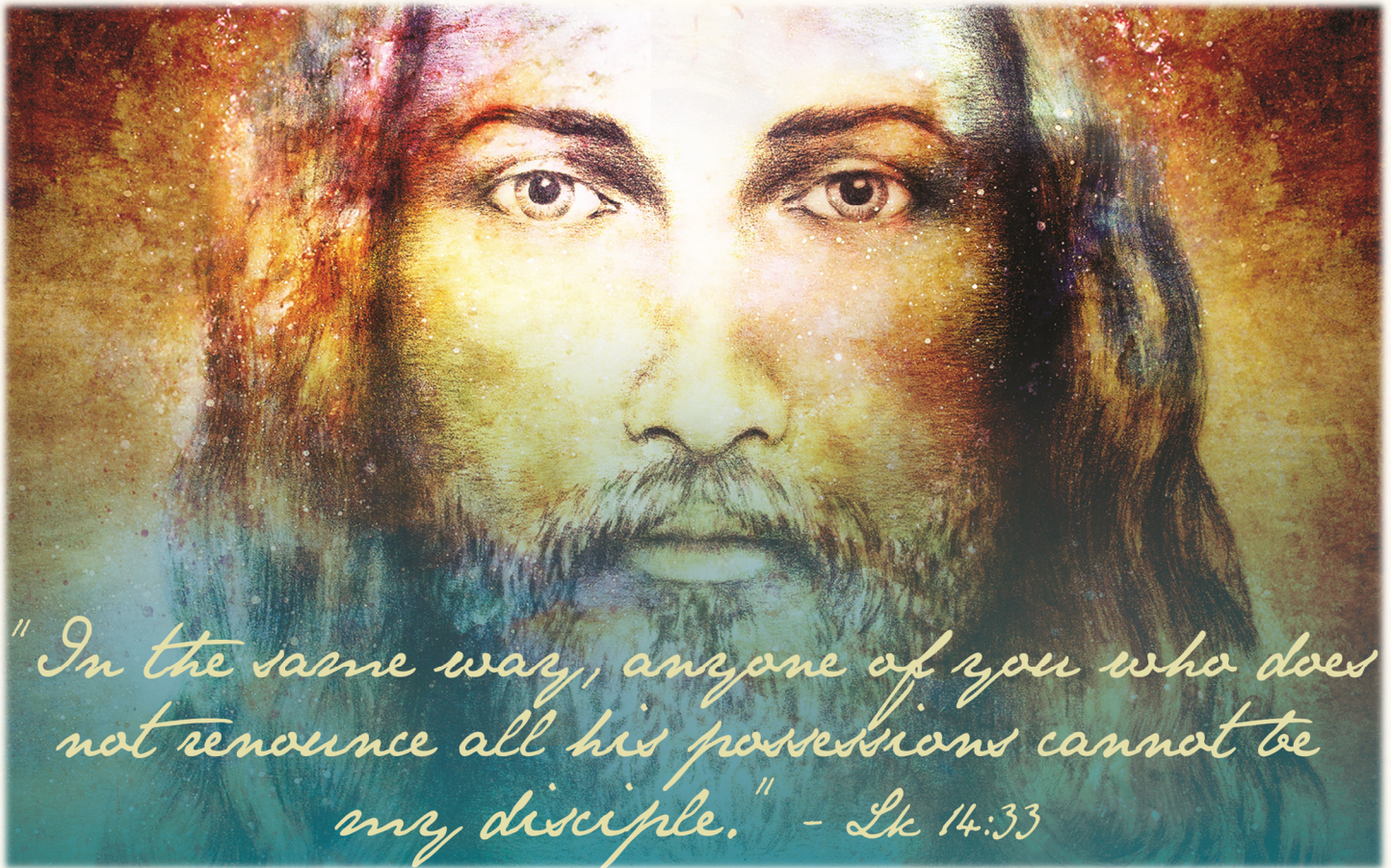


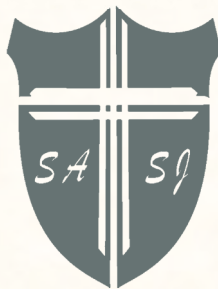

The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

The expectation of Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church is that upon entering into a Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a Religious Education program for at least one full year prior. Once entered into a Sacramental program, it is the expectation that the youth will attend classes and retreats faithfully. If you know your child is going to be absent on a scheduled class day, please notify the teacher, DRE or Dir of Faith Formation. 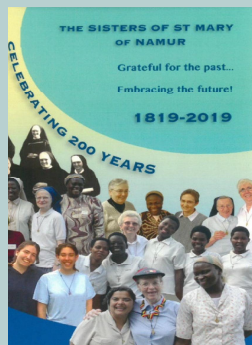
