

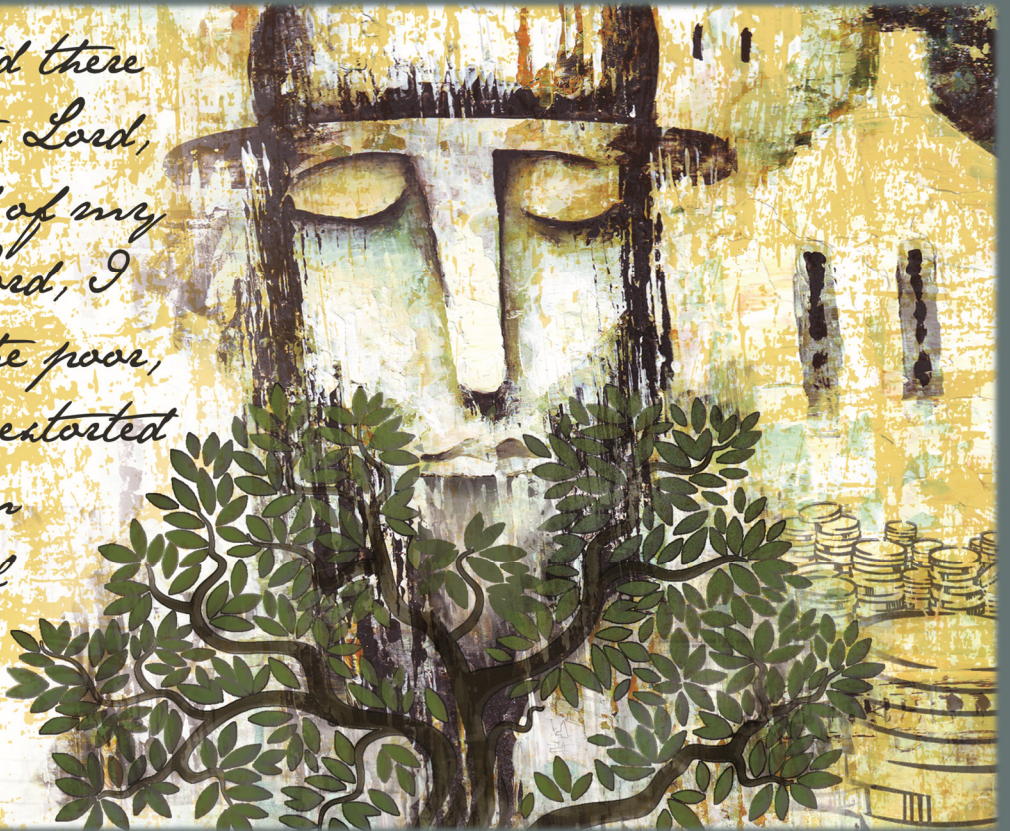

The Diocese of Charleston Policy on Sacramental Preparation

The expectation of Saint Anne and Saint Jude Roman Catholic Church is that upon entering into a Sacramental program, the youth would have attended a Religious Education program for at least one full year prior.
