Key Note Speaker - Sean Forrest

In January of 2000, Sean founded Movin' With The Spirit, Inc. (MWTS), a not-for-profit organization dedicated to boldly proclaiming God's eternal truth and love. The group's mission is to reach out to the lost and lonely in the name of Christ. Since then, Sean has had the opportunity to speak to hundreds of thousands of teens and adults across the country and internationally. He has been a guest on multiple programs on the Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN) and has been featured in nationally recognized magazines and newspapers. Sean has performed and spoken at venues such as: The National Catholic Youth Conference, World Youth Day, and the Creation fest and Soul fest Christian music festivals. He is an annual keynote speaker at the Steubenville youth conferences and challenges men at diocesan men's conferences throughout the country to live their faith and lead others to Christ. He reaches out to both the hearts and minds of his audiences, in keeping with the focus of Pope John Paul II's Fides et Ratio (Faith and Reason). Building on his organization's work in the U.S., Sean has also mobilized a team to house, feed, and care for the poor of Haiti-children and villagers in desperate need of support. Haiti180 constructed and operates a chapel, lively orphanage, state-of-the-art school, and home for the elderly and a medical clinic for the local and surrounding communities. The Catholic Digest published an article about his mission in Haiti and EWTN recently did a two-part documentary with Chris Stefanik from Real Life Catholic on Haiti180. Sean is a graduate of Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Cromwell, Connecticut, where he did work as an instructor and retreat leader. He now lives in Nashville, TN with his wife Julie and three children.

LIVE THE LITURGY

Families can be challenging. As much as they can be places of love, growth, and life, they can also be places of hurt, conflict, and despair. What has been your experience of family? There is no way around it: being human requires family life. We have to learn how to celebrate and embrace as well as forgive and understand. Virtue is required. St. Paul asks us to "put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience." We are asked to bear with one another and forgive one another. These are tall orders for anyone, but they are not impossible achievements. If we keep our eyes on Jesus and trust in God as the Holy Family did, St. Paul's vision is obtainable. Our families can take on a sacramental character and become places where God's love is revealed. ©LPi



GOSPEL MEDITATION

"Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you." 725 kilometers. That's the distance on modern roads from Bethlehem to Cairo. Assuming one covered 40km a day on foot – ambitious for two young parents and their infant son – the journey would take well over two weeks. Of course, the Holy Family didn't have modern roads. They would travel through wilderness, fear bandits, run low on water, and cross the vast Sinai Peninsula in a reverse of their forefathers in Exodus. Here, in struggle and sacrifice, are the beginnings of the forging of the Holy Family. "Joseph rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed for Egypt. He stayed there until the death of Herod." Large Jewish communities existed in most major cities of the ancient Mediterranean world, after the collapse of their kingdoms chronicled in the Old Testament, and Joseph could likely find work as a carpenter. All the same, today's Gospel reminds us that the first formational years of Jesus as a babe-in-arms were spent in a strange land. The members of the Holy Family were foreigners, outsiders, immigrants. The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. God took on our humanity. He is in solidarity with our own trials and difficulties. On the feast of the Holy Family, we honor the special place of the family within society. We are invited, too, to recall those families who share in the struggles of the Holy Family in a particular way. We pray for immigrants, asylum seekers, and refugees. We pray for all parents who sacrifice their own well-being and comfort so their children may have a better life. ©LPi

San Pablo nos pide: "Pónganse, pues...la compasión tierna, la bondad, la humildad, la mansedumbre, la paciencia." Se nos pide que nos soportemos y nos perdonemos mutuamente. Estas son órdenes difíciles para cualquiera, pero no son logros imposibles. Si mantenemos nuestros ojos en Jesús y confiamos en Dios como lo hizo la Sagrada Familia, la visión de San Pablo se puede obtener. Nuestras familias pueden asumir un carácter sacramental y convertirse en lugares donde se revela el amor de Dios. ©LPi

Los consejos que se dan en las lecturas de hoy son luz que debe iluminar el hogar y debemos practicarlos durante el año. El libro de Sirácide dice así: "El Señor honra al padre en los hijos y respalda la autoridad de la madre sobre la prole." San Pablo lo resume de la siguiente manera: "Que en sus corazones reine la paz de Cristo, esa paz a la que han sido llamados, como miembros de un solo cuerpo." En el Evangelio se ve el cómo actúa José y María para proteger a su hijo: "Levántate, toma al niño y a su madre, y huye a Egipto." Consejos del Papa Francisco para la familia: "A los recién casados les doy siempre este consejo: 'Reñid lo que queráis. Si vuelan los platos, dejadlos. Pero nunca acabéis el día sin hacer las paces. ¡Nunca!'" "Para hacer las paces no hace falta llamar a Naciones Unidas, que venga a casa a hacer la paz. Basta un gesto pequeño, una caricia: 'Bueno, adiós, hasta mañana'. Y mañana se comienza de nuevo". ¿Qué te anima de estos consejos? ¿Qué harás por tu familia actualmente? ©LPi
