Dear Parishioners,

Peace of Jesus Christ be with all of you!

This past weekend, I shared with you that our parish school, St. Anne & St. Jude Catholic School, will reorganize its operational structure. As I said in Mass, this was difficult decision that was made after much prayer, discernment, and discussion among school and diocesan officials, but one that will give our beloved school a pathway to sustainability instead of closing. I am confident our plan will help save our school, give more Sunter students the opportunity to obtain a Catholic pre-K and elementary education, and give our 7th through 12th grade students the chance to receive a more well-rounded middle and high school experience.

As was announced in Mass, beginning this fall, our Catholic school will serve grades K4-6 and will be named Holy Angels Academy. The K-4 class will provide access to pre-K education for eligible families and students through the First Steps program. Multiage classrooms will be utilized in grades K-5 through 6, which will allow teachers to more effectively identify student strengths and needs and deliver personalized and differentiate instruction. Moreover, to give more Sunter parents the ability to send their children to Holy Angels Academy, the cost of tuition will decrease from \$4,590 per year to \$3,500 per year.

We have also joined into a partnership with Cardinal Newman School in Columbia to give our middle and high school students the opportunity to continue their Catholic education. Transportation will be provided to students from Sunter to the Cardinal Newman campus (and vice versa). Most importantly, the middle and high school students will be able to learn in a challenging, Catholic environment while having the opportunity to participate in the dozens of advanced academic classes, the arts, and extra-curricular activities that St. Anne & St. Jude Catholic School cannot offer due to its small size.

Unfortunately, the reorganization will result in the elimination of those jobs that serve grades 7-12. Know that we will do our very best to assist these faculty and staff members through this challenging transition period.

Making Catholic education available in Sunter is our top priority. I believe our common mission as Catholics, and as members of this wonderful community, is to continue St. Anne & St. Jude Catholic School's legacy regardless of how big or how small it becomes in the coming years. Our children are the future of our Church and of the world. While they are in their formative years, let us help them through service, stewardship and prayer. Encourage families to consider Catholic education for their children, find ways to support our school financially and spiritually, and most of all, be involved in this precious ministry God has given to us.

Mainstream historians left out African Americans from the narrative of American history up until the 1960s, and Woodson worked his entire career to correct this blinding oversight.

Ernest A. Finney Jr

An outstanding defense lawyer, and civil rights advocate. He defended more than 6,000 clients who had been arrested for taking part in sit-ins, freedom rides, and demonstrations.

Because the legal system in South Carolina protected segregation he lost almost every case that went to trial. But won all but two on appeal to a higher Court this is how we tired chief justice Ernest a Finney is described in a South Carolina Hall of Fame transcript. Judge Finney was elected Chief Justice on May 11th 1994 making him the first African-American Chief Justice of South Carolina since reconstruction.

Judge Finney was born in Smithfield Virginia in 1931 he graduated from Clayton College in 1952 and then earned in 1954 from the South Carolina State University School of Law a Juris doctor degree.

In 1960, he had his family moves to Sumter South Carolina where he opened his law practice. In 1961 penny represented the Friendship nine a group of black junior college students arrested for a sit-in in Rock Hill South Carolina. In 1963 he served as chairman of the South Carolina Commission on civil rights. In 1972 he was elected to the South Carolina House of Representatives and served on the Judiciary Committee. In 1976 he was elected the first black circuit court judge in 1985 through the year 2000 he was elected to South Carolina Supreme Court in 1994 he was elected Chief Justice of South Carolina Supreme Court retired South Carolina Supreme Court chief justice Ernest a Finney Jr passed away in 2017.

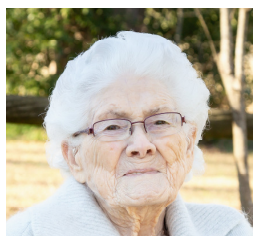
