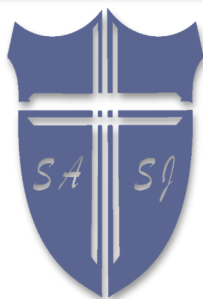

## Plan for reopening the church the third weekend of August Saturday, August 15th and Sunday, August 16th

- We are excited to finally go back in the Church to celebrate the Mass. Due to the number of people that can be safely seated while maintaining appropriate social distancing, we will use the St. Anne location for most of the well-attended Masses to accommodate more people.
- To serve as many parishioners as possible during a weekend English Mass, the Parish Hall at St. Anne will be opened for as many as **60** additional parishioners. The mass will be live streamed onto the big screen. Eucharistic Ministers will be sent to the Parish Hall to distribute communion.
- The weekend mass schedule will be:
  - Saturday 5 p.m. – St. Anne**
  - Sunday 8 a.m. – St. Anne**
  - Sunday 10 a.m. – St. Anne**
  - Sunday 12 noon in Spanish – St. Jude**
  - Sunday 5 p.m. – St. Jude**
- Daily Mass will go back to normal times: **Monday - Wednesday 7 a.m. in the St Jude location; Thursday-Saturday 8:15 a.m. in the St. Anne location.**
- Prior to admittance into the masses, all parishioners and Liturgical Ministers will have their temperature taken by a Thermal Scan Thermometer. Any person with a temperature of above **98.6** will be advise that they may not attend mass.
- Parishioners will be required to wear a mask at all times.
- While inside the church, to observe social distancing as much as possible, we will use a reverse process for receiving communion. Parishioners will exit their pews to the side aisles approach the altar and then return to their seats from the center aisle.
- Couples and Families who live in the same household may sit together. Single parishioners are not encouraged to sit with non-family members.
- We will have a no-contact drop box for the offertory
- We will continue the use of the single use reading and songbook. Parishioners will pick these up from a no-contact table at the entrance of the church and throw them away upon leaving the mass.
- Bulletins will be made available by no-contact table as well.
- There will be trash bins placed outside of the church. Parishioners will be reminded to dispose of their own single use reading and song papers at the end of mass.
- Bathroom facilities are for emergency use only.
- Cry rooms at both locations are limited to one family only and should be reserved for a family with children.
- After every mass, a sanitizing mist will be used on all the hard and soft surfaces in the church.
- We will utilize as few volunteers as necessary to maintain proper social distancing for the parishioners attending mass.

This is the plan for reopening the church while we are observing **SOCIAL DISTANCING**.

We are Grateful for your continued understanding and patience.

### Recognize God In Your Ordinary Moments

#### The Power of a Simple Action

I remember seeing a story on a morning news program about a little girl who wanted to give an elderly man in a grocery store a hug. She had no way of knowing that this man had just lost his wife of many years and now felt so very alone and depressed. Her reaching out to the man seemed odd to her mom at first, but the girl was so insistent about giving a hug she moved the shopping carts close together so the exchange could take place. No one knew that from that moment on the little girl would ask to visit her new friend at least once a week for the next four years until he passed away. In an interview soon after the initial encounter, the man said, "I haven't been this happy in some time." Imagine the joy that relationship brought to them both over the years!

It was just a moment. It was a simple gesture. Yet, it had a large impact that no one could have predicted. You never know what will result when we give just a little of ourselves. That uncertainty too often leads us to hold back or refrain from the simple actions of love or gestures of generosity that could come so easily for us if we wanted. We should never doubt the power of a simple random act of kindness. Generosity does not need to be grand to make a big difference. The time is now, and the opportunity presents itself often to plant a small seed that God can water and nourish so that something beautiful can grow.

##### Second Reading

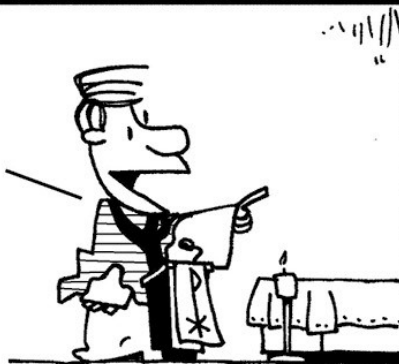

## 521 PROJECT UPDATE (June 24, 2020)

Our primary concern currently is with COVID 19 issues, illness with tragic loss of life as well as safety concerns. Mass at St Anne and St Jude Roman Catholic Church is being celebrated at outdoor services on our St Anne campus as well as thru Facebook live streaming. This evening, The Sumter City-County Planning Commission approved our request for a change in zoning of our 521 Property from Planned Development to General Commercial. Joey Duggan did a great job answering questions at this important meeting. Our next step is to have 2 readings at the Sumter City Council meetings before the City Council can approve our zoning request and building plans. Our new church building project is estimated to cost 6 million dollars. We have 2.6 million dollars from our One Faith/One Family Capital Campaign and 2.3 million dollars in pledges from our combined Bicentennial Campaign and It's TIME Campaign. We have collected \$727,000.00 from these pledges. We plan to borrow the remaining monies needed for our building project from the Diocese. We appreciate your continued prayers and support.
