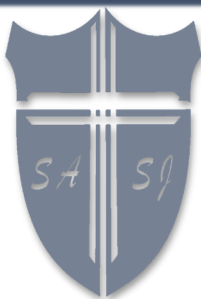

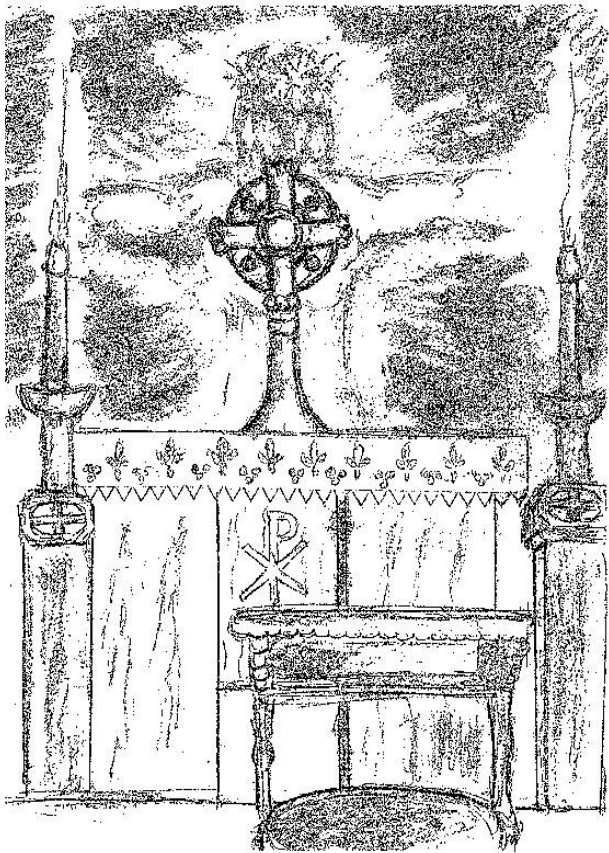

## St. Jude Catholic Church and our Catholic History

Being raised as an African American Female in the Catholic church has always been a unique experience. It would always start with "what church do you attend?" and end with a surprised look. Honestly it was most common for someone of my ethnicity (especially living in the South) to be Baptist, AME, or even Non-Denominational. However, that wasn't my story. I honestly believe that my involvement with St. Jude Catholic Church has provided me a sturdy and steady religious and spiritual foundation that I still value to this day.

Our history centered at St. Jude began with my Mother and father John and Roberta Carter. Roberta grew up affiliated with New Bethel AME and Mt. Pisgah AME church located in Sumter South Carolina and John was affiliated with the Baptist Church. Once married, both John and Roberta became interested in joining a church together and this is where they began their religious journey as practicing Catholics of St. Jude. I once asked my mom why she decided to become catholic and she expressed that her observance of St. Jude in the surrounding community is what made her the most interested. She often said that each Nun and Priest affiliated with St. Jude was always so "nice" and "personable" which influenced her decision to join the church. Not only was she influenced but at least 3 of her older siblings (Wilma Royster, Bonnah Mae Ellerbee, and Martha Schoefield) also became catholic and participated in various groups connected to the catholic church. One of which (Bonnah Mae Ellerbee) was member of St. Jude.

Both my mother and father participated in many groups affiliated with the Catholic church one of which was the Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies of Peter Claver Auxiliary, 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Ladies of Grace, Greeters, and a host of other volunteer opportunities. They both dedicated their time and efforts to serve their church and surrounding community as she also worked at a Special Education Teacher for the Sumter School District for 31 years and my father for Exide (a battery manufacturing company).

My older brother (John L. Carter) and I dedicated our time serving as altar servers in the church as well as participating in the Youth Group. John also served some time in the Knights of Peter Claver as well. John and his wife (Monica Carter) and two children (Diamond Carter and Kristal Carter) have also played integral parts in the church participating in the Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies Auxiliary, Altar Servers, Youth Groups, etc.

St. Jude has played such a valuable and rich part of my family's religious history. I have been influenced by so many wonderful people who have influenced so much of my upbringing among those being my God parents Vernessa Baker and the late John McDonald, who also participated in a number of groups in the St. Jude Parish community (Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies Auxiliary, Greeters, Choir, Eucharistic Ministers, etc.).

It is apparent that I come from a rich catholic history that surrounded me with family and community that have been building blocks of who I currently am today. St. Jude's influence of family and community urged me to center my career around caring for others through pursuing a position in the mental health field where I also spend time influencing families to invest time in each other.

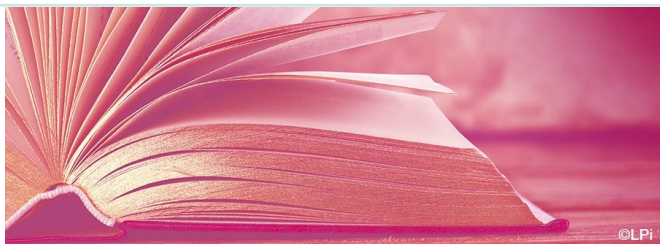
