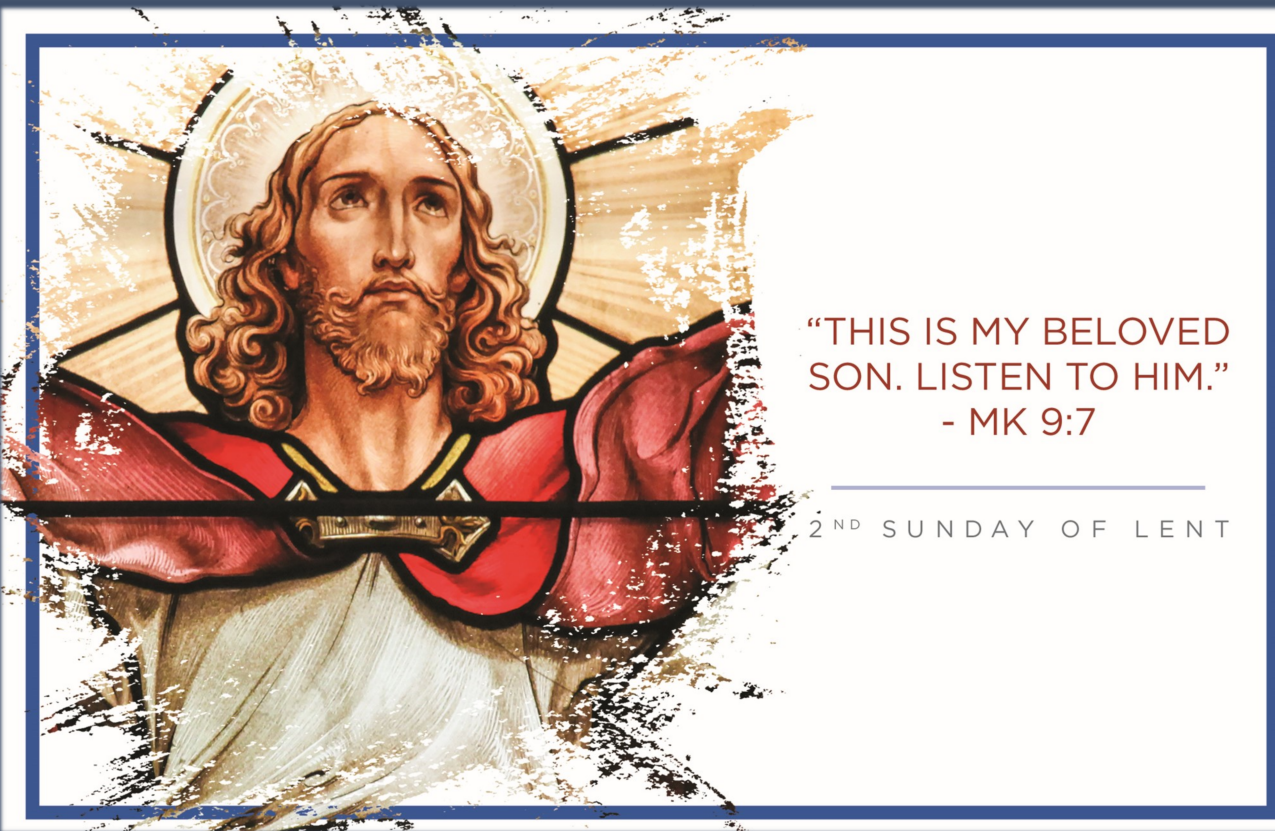

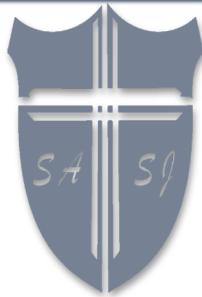

Rev. Fr. Jason Caganap, CRM, JCL is a member of the Clerics Regular Minor (Adorno Fathers). He was born in Manila, Philippines and is the youngest of the three children of Fidelino Sr. and Rosalia Caganap.

Fr. Jay, as he is called by his friends, graduated from St. Mary Magdalene High School in 1993 and received his Bachelors Degree in Philosophy from Christ the King Mission Seminary.

He joined St. Michaels Formation House (Adorno Fathers Seminary) in Ramsey, New Jersey in 1997 and studied at Immaculate Conception School of Theology - Seton Hall University where he obtained his Masters in Divinity Major in Pastoral Ministry. He professed his Solemn Religious

Vows on June 22, 2002 and was ordained to the priesthood on December 7, 2002 at Immaculate Conception Parish in Goose Creek, SC.

After his assignment as Parochial Vicar of St. Joseph Parish in Lodi, New Jersey, he continued a post -graduate studies in Canon Law and received a licentiate in Canon Law (Summa Cum Laude) from the Pontifical Lateran University in Rome, Italy. He worked as a Canon Lawyer, Defender of the Bond and Judge of the Metropolitan Tribunals of the Archdiocese of Newark in New Jersey (2007-2009) and Ecclesiastical Tribunal of Caceres in the Philippines (2009-2013). In 2009, he was assigned as Rector/Superior and Novice Master of the Adorno Fathers Seminary in Vinzons, Camarines Norte, Philippines.

He is a member of the Canon Law Society of America and Canon Law Society of the Philippines. He also worked as Chairman of the Ministry on Prayer (Office for Prayer and Sacrifice), member of the College of Consultors and Presbyteral Council of the Diocese of Daet (Camarines Norte, Philippines) from 2009 to 2013. He was appointed Pastor of Immaculate Conception Church in Goose Creek by Most Reverend Robert E. Guglielmone on June 15, 2013 until he was called to a different ministry in 2018. He is currently the Superior of the US-Phil Delegation of the Adorno Fathers since 2018.

Everywhere Sharry and Mitchell's military journey took them, they formed long lasting and cherished friendships. ## WHY DO WE USE INCENSE AT MASS?

The use of incense in religious ceremonies and worship is a practice that predates Christianity, and which is also found in many other religious traditions today.

Incense, which is made from resin infused with aromatic spices and oils, is one of those fundamentally human symbols that incorporates more than one of our senses, helping us to reflect on realities that transcend the everyday details of our lives.

The use of incense in the Church's liturgy — in the Mass, as well as in devotions to the Eucharist and the Liturgy of the Hours — is inspired by the use of incense in the Jewish tradition. In the writings of the Old Testament, we hear about incense being used in the

worship of the temple, and Psalm 141 asks, "Let my prayer be incense before you; my uplifted hands an evening offering" (vs. 2). The image here is that, as the incense gently rises to heaven, our prayers also rise to God as something sweet and pleasant.



Another ancient use of incense that has also become part of our Catholic tradition is the idea that when we incense something, it's because it is something special or sacred. This is why the Book of the Gospel is incensed during the Liturgy of the Word and the bread, wine, priest celebrant, and congregation are incensed at the presentation of the gifts. To this, we can also add the incensing of the Blessed Sacrament during eucharistic

adoration and benediction, and the body of the deceased at the end of the Mass of the Resurrection (the Funeral Mass).
