# OUR NEW CHURCH

521 PROJECT UPDATE  
JULY 22 2021

- Projected monies available for our building project is 4.45 million dollars (soft costs estimated at .6 million), 3.85 million net for site work and building. OFOF D&L 48720 3.24 million cash It's TIME 1.21 million pledges Total monies 4.45 million cash and pledges
- We have worked with the value engineers at Mashburn Construction to get our building project within budget. We plan to reduce the size of our new church from 16000 sq feet (800 seats) to 10,000 sq feet (400 seats), and, as before, we plan to build a cross shaped church with red brick.
- We are hoping to form an artifact subcommittee in order to catalogue artifacts from St Annes and St Judes Church, and then determine which artifacts will be used in our new church, and the timing of moving and placement of artifacts.
- The Building Committee met on 21 July with Rob Montgomery, our architect, to review our new church plans (10,000 sq feet) and building site adjustments.
- We had a positive BRAC presentation earlier this month and plan a follow up BRAC presentation in October after engineering documents have been completed.
- We have applied for a loan from the Diocese for 1.2 million, based on our outstanding pledges only. We plan a **Town Hall** meeting for **Wednesday August 11, 7pm**, at the St Anne Parish Hall. ★
- Pending BRAC and Loan approval, we plan to have a "shovel in the ground" in January 2022 and worship in our new church by Christmas 2022.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The lens through which we view life makes a difference. It also determines who we choose to learn from and what we allow to shape our thoughts and feelings. For many, life is simply what it appears to be, a given that either through evolution or some other means just came to be. There is no apparent rhyme or reason to things and things can be dissected and understood only in terms of what they empirically present. To the person using this lens, a tree is a tree and a flower is a flower. Their composition and existence can be understood only to the extent that current human knowledge allows. Through this lens, what gives life purpose and meaning? This lens has an essentially unknown beginning and definite end. Once those are accepted, the middle becomes some kind of pursuit of happiness, with values and principles being things that are self-created and found acceptable.

But there is a Divine lens that also exists and deserves mention. It is found when one stumbles upon faith and begins to see things differently. This lens is of God and reveals a Divine Energy and Life that flows through and in all things. Faith then shows us that all that lives come from this one Source of Love. This is the only

#### **Inspiration for the week**

Are we willing to be taught by God? If we are, then we will begin to see things and make judgments using a Divine lens. Often, we perceive things with purely human eyes and reference points. When we do this, reality can lose its Divine spark and we miss what God is trying to say. When using human eyes exclusively, Jesus is at best perceived simply as a prophet who has some wise things to say. The human element has a difficult time seeing Jesus' divinity and recognizing him as the Bread of Life that comes down from heaven. We can easily get stuck on Jesus' human associations and overlook the marvelous wonders God wants us to see. If we really allow ourselves to be taught by God, we will then come to see the truth about Jesus and the abundant everlasting life God offers. Jesus becomes the key that unlocks all of our relationships: with God, others, ourselves, and creation. He, as the true and lasting bread from heaven, shows us the gifts of faith, hope, and love that God bestows on us. Through this divine lens we see that all life sparkles and glows with God's love.

true lens that can give human beings the purpose and meaning they desperately need. From this perspective, all of life is much more than what is immediately apparent! It now tells and reveals a story about God generous, creative, and unconditional love! The unfolding of the human story is the unfolding of God's story. What meaning our lives have when they are viewed as a part of God's love affair with humanity! We are indeed special.

The lens of our faith asks us to learn from Jesus Christ. Jesus, as the real Bread of Life, shows us our eternal destiny and completes

and frames our lives. It is only in allowing ourselves to be taught by Jesus, that faith, hope, and love take on much greater importance. All the relationships in our lives are now structured and ordered using God's primary commandment of love. Jesus, then, is not just some man who lived at some point in history. Jesus is the incarnate Son of God who shows us the way, the truth, and the life. Using this lens changes things up a great deal. Looking at the creation that surrounds you and the special unique people you love, what is God trying to teach you about His love for you and the eternal life He wants you to have?

### **ESL, LITERACY AND CULTURE MINISTRY**

We are starting a new ministry designed to serve Hispanic families. Some of these adults speak no English and many are illiterate. We plan to serve the whole family providing cultural activities for the children while the parents are in class.

The classes will start in the fall and end in the spring. They will take place Sundays at 11 am at St Jude just before the Spanish Mass.
