

## 2021-2022 Low Hanging Fruit

- 8. Facilities
  - Discontinue the practice of taping flyers to doors and walls. Install wall document holders on doors to put flyers in when needed
  - Paint front of Youth Building
  - Paint the front of St. Jude's church
  - Paint St. Jude's Parish Hall and make necessary repairs to improve appearance
- 9. Establish Small Groups
  - Young Couples Bible Study, Life skills (budgeting, time management, etc)
  - Young Adults
  - 10. In search of God Nights (IGNIGHT) First and Third Wednesday of each month community and faith building nights. Ministries to meet in St. Jude Church for 15 minutes of music and prayer before breaking out into smaller groups. At the end of the night everyone will gather for a final prayer and blessing. This will build up the energy and community within our parish
