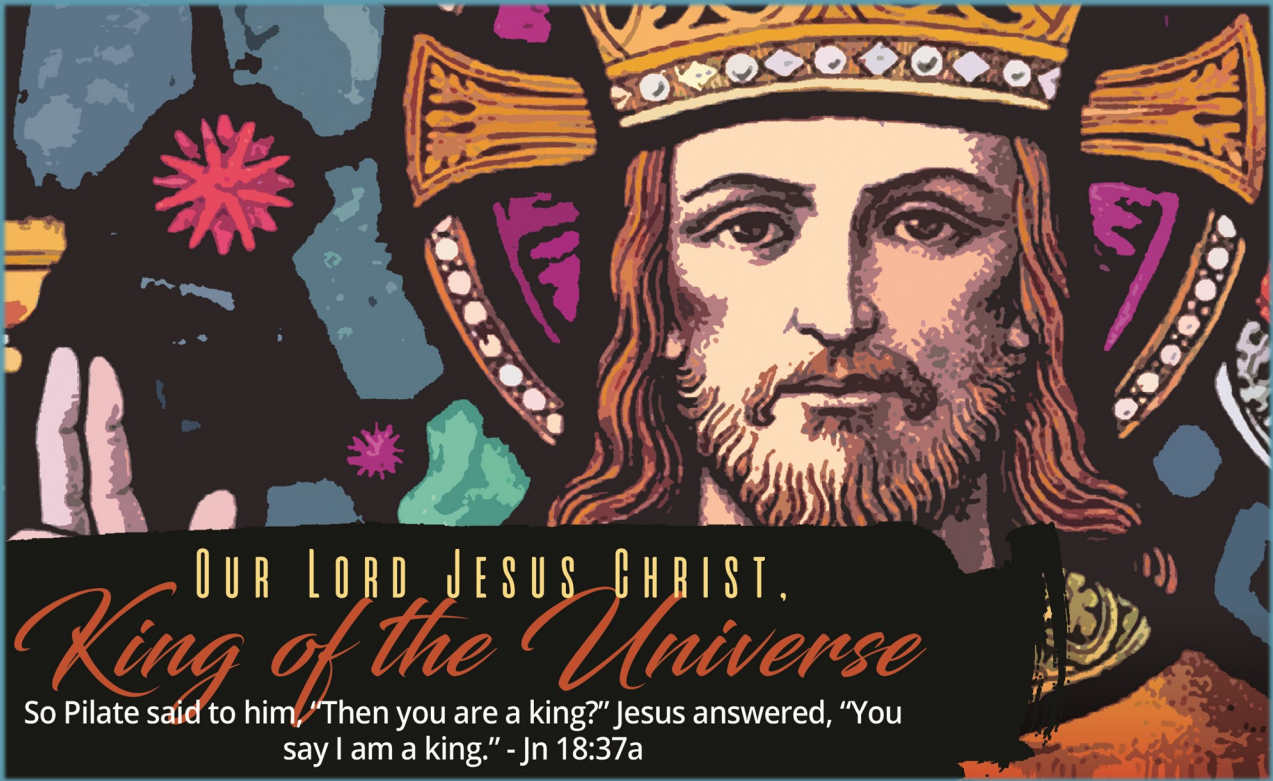

There is a saying — find your people. I say, find your people, and find a way to lay yourself down for them, in imitation of the greatest King that ever was.

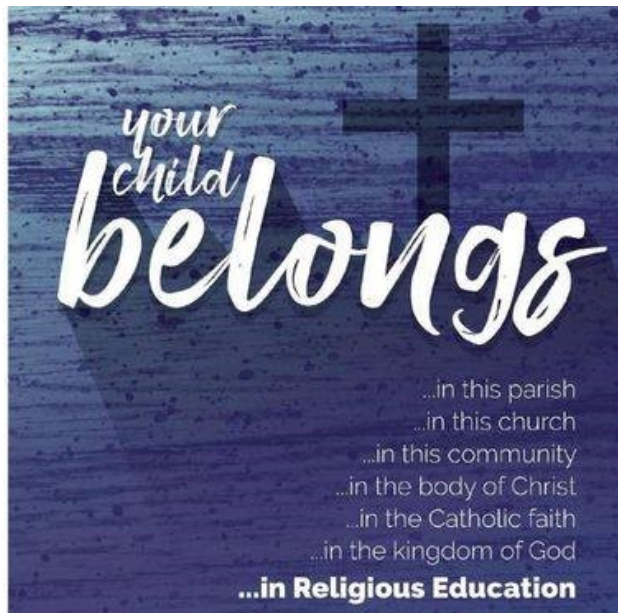

OUR NEW CHURCH UPDATE NOV 1, 2021

- Projected monies available for our building project is 4.45 million dollars (soft costs estimated at .6 million), 3.85 million net for site work and building. OFOF D&L 48720 3.24 million cash It's TIME 1.21 million pledges Total monies 4.45 million cash and pledges.
- We have applied for a loan from the Diocese for 1.2 million, based on our outstanding pledges only. Because we have ongoing pledges redemption, we will probably need a loan for only 500k.
- We had a meeting with Mashburn Construction on October 25 to review our updated building plans and assess value engineering . We have a follow up meeting with Mashburn on Nov 18 in Columbia.
- We plan a BRAC presentation on Thursday 11 November for approval of our updated site plan and construction documents.
- We have formed a 10 member Artifact Committee to catalogue and recommend which artifacts we transfer to our new church and the timing of the transfer. Our first meeting was on October 11 and the second meeting was October 25. This committee is also pricing pews for our new church.
- We are in the process of obtaining civil engineered civil site plan approval from The Sumter Planning Commission (on their meeting agenda for December 13) and obtaining building permits.
- Pending BRAC and Loan approval, we plan to have a "shovel in the ground" in January 2022 and worship in our new church by Christmas 2022.
