It has been over a year since our parish completed our participation in the *Bicentennial and It's Time Campaign* to build a new Church. As a reminder, your support and generosity helped us raise **\$1,800,000** in pledges from **243 parishioners**, which is **129.71%** of our target. To date, **\$1,343,752.13** has been received from these pledge payments, and with those funds, we have been able to ensure our financial capacity to break ground on January 22, 2022 and look forward to completing our New Church this year.

We recognize the financial uncertainty that COVID-19 has caused for many in our community. Saint Anne and Saint Jude Parish has not been immune from these challenges. Despite the obstacles that have been placed in our way, we are still amazed at the support parishioners continue to show for our parish in the form of continued payments on their Bicentennial Campaign pledges. It is your devotion that will allow our spiritual home to persevere and flourish through these difficult times.

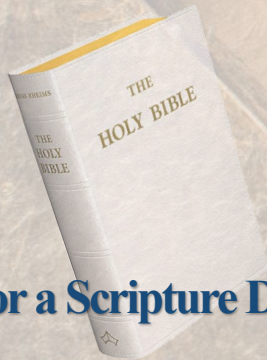

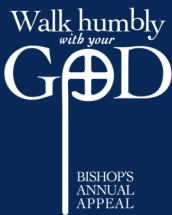

OUR NEW CHURCH

521 PROJECT UPDATE February 6 2022

- Following Sumter City and County Planning Commission approval and Charleston Diocese Loan approval (based on outstanding pledges), we enjoyed a Groundbreaking Ceremony on January 22, 2022 Bishop Guglielmone presided at the ceremony. The Adornos were well represented and included Father Gio, Father Geri, Father Ronie, and Father Frank. Kelly Bruce, Director of Planning and Operations from the Charleston Diocese, and Dave Pfrommer, our BRAC consultant attended. Rob Montgomery, our architect, and representatives from Mashburn Construction were present. Nickie Macedo and Cindy Tavarez took multiple photos which are posted on our website. Deacon Greg and our youth were present to witness and participate in this ceremony. 150 Parishoners were present.
- Over 100 volunteers have been involved with this project thru their service on 10 committees and councils. Dr Mary Blanchard attended a synod 25 years ago and returned with a recommendation to build a new church. The committee and council members were recognized to include the Long Range Planning Committee, the 521 Farm Partnership, the Future Catholic Community Committee, One Faith One Family Fundraising, the Steering Committee, the Building Committee, It's TIME Campaign, Parish Councils, Finance Councils, and the Artifact Committee. The Artifact Committee has made recommendations concerning the St Anne stained glass window scheduling. We plan to use 21 of 43 windows in our new church, and we plan to use most of the remaining windows in future buildings. We are looking at using the St Jude stained glass window inside our new church. The Artifact Committee plans to interview pew vendors soon and continues to work on cataloging artifacts from St Anne and St Jude Church campuses. We are in the process of obtaining site permits. We have completed our application for a SCDOT Encroachment Permit for the water and lines to be constructed on Beckwood Road. In addition, we have executed an Indemnity and Insurance agreement with Mashburn and the city of Sumter. Thanks to all for continued support and prayers. It's TIME
