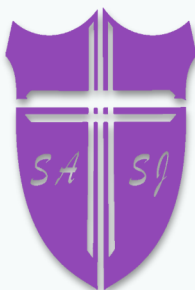

To date, **\$1,343,752.13** has been received from these pledge payments, and with those funds, we have been able to ensure our financial capacity to break ground on January 22, 2022 and look forward to completing our New Church this year.

We recognize the financial uncertainty that COVID-19 has caused for many in our community. Saint Anne and Saint Jude Parish has not been immune from these challenges. Despite the obstacles that have been placed in our way, we are still amazed at the support parishioners continue to show for our parish in the form of continued payments on their Bicentennial Campaign pledges. There is so much wisdom in the first commandment. The daily demands of life, current political ideologies and dynamics, social expectations, corporate philosophies, and even technology can easily become lesser gods. We can find ourselves beholden to and held captive by these secular constructs and systems. Even for those who profess a faith in the one true God, these lesser, attractive but false gods are a temptation. Being overly preoccupied and even obsessed with the state of our present lives, we lose sight of our real destiny and purpose.

Jesus showed his disciples a glimpse of this destiny when he was transfigured before their eyes. In fact, Peter was so caught up in the brilliance, awe, and sacredness of these fleeting moments that he wanted to extend them as long as possible. Wonderful things happen when we leave our illusions and discover something that is true. This is why creating some sacred space in our lives for reflection, prayer, renewal, refreshment, centering ourselves, and

Inspiration for the week

While we have to be cognizant of our societal and personal responsibilities in this world, we can never lose sight of where our true citizenship lies — heaven. When we become too immersed in earthly things and too preoccupied with our temporal responsibilities, we can actually become numb to our faith. Becoming ambivalent about our faith, our belief in Jesus Christ and the promises of heaven become more a source of agitation rather than a source of promise and hope. It is easy to become an enemy of Christ without even knowing it is happening. God has given us a very clear destiny. We are definitely not meant to conform ourselves to this world but to the transfiguration and glorification of our bodies to come. It is here where we can see clearly not only who God is but who we are. The way many conduct the daily business of their lives suggests that such a promise or hope is of little importance. What does the way you live your daily life say about you?

disconnecting from the noise is so important. It shows us how false and shallow our lives can be and what is really of importance. Do you create some kind of sacred space in your life? Lent is a perfect time to do so.

St. Irenaeus, one of the early fathers and martyrs of the Catholic Church, said that, “he who was the Son of God became the Son of Man that man ... might become the son of God.” We mistakenly believe that life is all about us. It’s not. Ours is a journey of transformation in which we

become more and more one with the mind of Christ and Christ himself. St. Augustine saw this same transformation occurring when the Eucharist is received. In receiving the Eucharist, we become what we eat, the Body of Christ. Honestly acknowledging false gods that we cling to can open the door for God to show us the wholeness and holiness to which we are called. Take time to discover the sacred. When we do, we will want to stay there for a while. Then, when we return to our personal affairs, we will see more clearly.

521 PROJECT UPDATE Feb 16 2021

We had a meeting with Mashburn Construction yesterday to finalize our budget after we received bids from subcontractors. In addition, we have addressed requirements found during the permitting process. Kelly Bruce and Dave Pfrommer from the Diocese as well as Rob Montgomery, our architect, also attended this meeting. This was a lengthy meeting with line-item analysis. We are \$110,000.00 over budget with construction costs (hard costs) but have offset this with a reduction in soft costs to stay within budget. The total project cost, including a contingency allowance, is the same at 5 million dollars. The next step is to obtain a Land Disruption permit from the State now that our SCDOT and city permits have been approved. Mashburn Construction is "ready to go" once we have the Land Disruption permit. Mashburn Construction expects to have machinery on site within the first two weeks in March. Because of subcontractor and supply issues our new St Anne and St Jude Church may not be completed until sometime in January or February of next year. Your support is much appreciated, keep praying!!
